Did you know that a town in Kerry is the first in Ireland to put a stop to single-use coffee cups? And that Kerry is home to many businesses committed to sustainability?

**BioAtlantis** Based in Tralee, BioAtlantis provides natural compounds extracted from renewable marine and terrestrial resources, to reduce stress in crops, animals and humans by strengthening natural defence systems.



**Dingle Distillery** The business has introduced various environmental initiatives allowing for a more sustainable distillation and production process. The spent grain and pot ale they use is now being reused as cattle feed by a local Dingle farm. This means the bulk of waste products from the distillery whiskey production are recycled back into the food chain!
