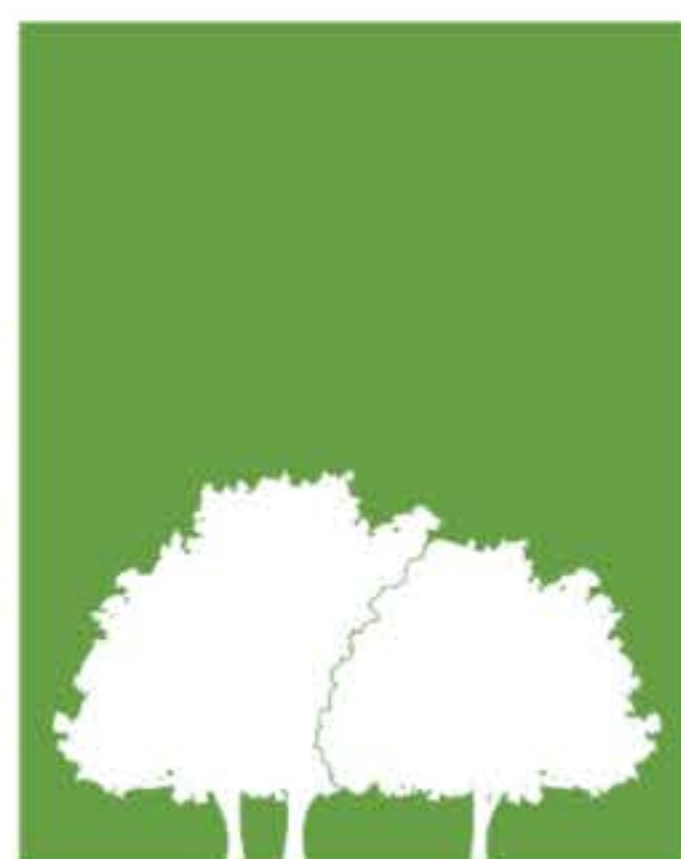
SUSTAINABLE BUSINESSES

Many businesses in county Louth are committed to sustainability, which in turn, help you buy and consume with less environmental impact.

Sustainable Protein Farms Based in Dundalk, this company produces insect meal and insect oil with very few resources. They use the natural process of degradation by insect larvae of surplus food (using food by-product materials from local food and beverage companies) to convert vegetable matter to animal protein and lipids. By using food by-products, they close the loop in the current food production system.



Farrell Based in Ardee, this company designs and makes furniture with sustainability in mind. All made locally in Ardee, they source their materials sustainably and rely on solvent-free polishing and varnishing techniques, as well as low-emission, chemical-free glues, as several other sustainable practices.
