**ecological BUILDING SYSTEMS**

**Ecological Building Systems** born in Athoby, the aim of this company is to create sustainable building solutions. They make use of more natural and environmentally friendly materials to optimise building performance and durability, and constantly look out for and assess the best, greener materials.

**Sloane Irish Whiskey Distillery** Based by the Sloane Castle grounds, this distillery follows very sustainable practices. Much of the water they use they source from rain water they collect, grain and yeast by-products are collected for local dairy farmers, so they can use it as animal feed, and they have integrated an anaerobic digester which converts distillation by-product into biogas.



**College Group** They produce animal feed ingredients and fertilisers from animal by-products and bio-waste. They divert materials away from landfill and incinerators to manufacture high-quality meal, protein, oil, and tallow. They are one of the biggest processors in Ireland.
