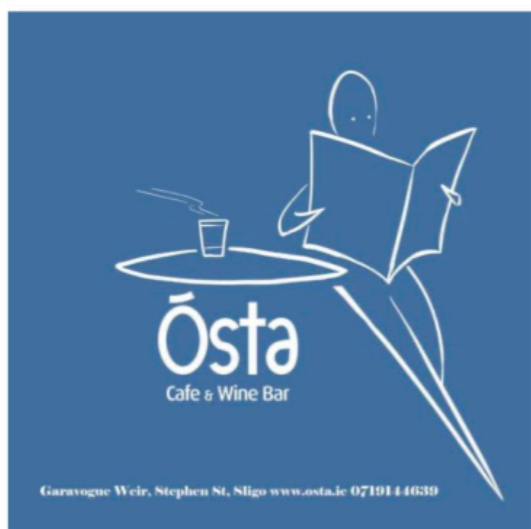

Osta Café & Wine Bar
They have supported local suppliers since they first opened in 2006. They use packaging that is 99% compostable and organic, and ethically sourced coffee and tea.
